

This Quick Guide helps you to get familiar with the updated version of your COMLOG*Flex* onboard unit. The Quick Guide is only an extract of the more detailed COMLOG*Flex* manual.

1. New features in the Message Module

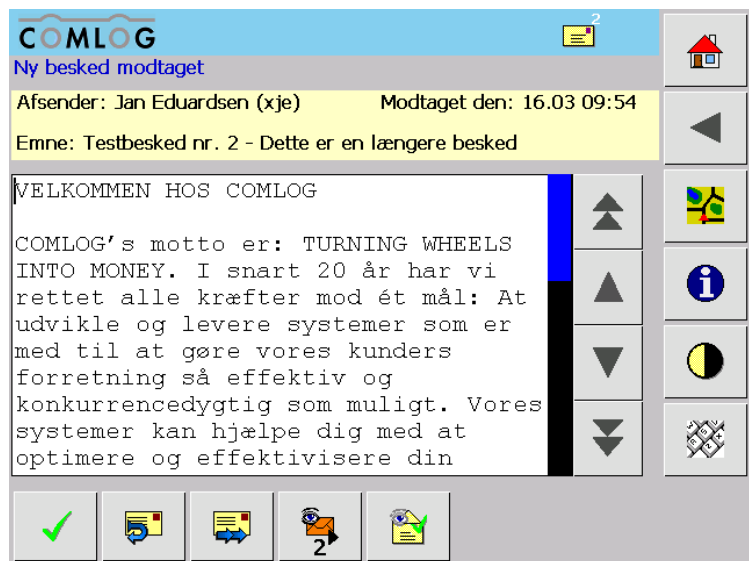
Important: Please note new placement of some keys, for instance 'Read message'!

- a) New message now as a pop-up
- b) Easier to navigate in a long message
- c) Easier to search receiver for your messages
- d) Messages time stamped when read by the receiver
- e) Message time stamped both when it is sent from the office and when it is received in the vehicle
- f) New sorting function: Sort by unread messages


a) New message as a pop-up

A pop-up now shows when a new message is received. You can:

-  close the pop-up window
-  send a reply
-  forward the message
-  go to next unread message
-  mark message as read

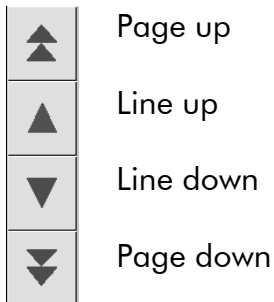


IMPORTANT: All messages, not only messages with a request for confirmation, must

now be marked by the  key in order the office can see that it has been read. If the key is not used, the message will remain as 'unread' in the COMLOG Fleet system at the office. Also you must navigate through all unread messages every time to get to the latest unread message.

b) Navigate in a long message

4 keys now replace the old standard Windows scrollbar. Use these keys to navigate in the message field.



c) Search receiver for a new message in the contact list

The onboard unit no longer automatically selects the first receiver on the list.

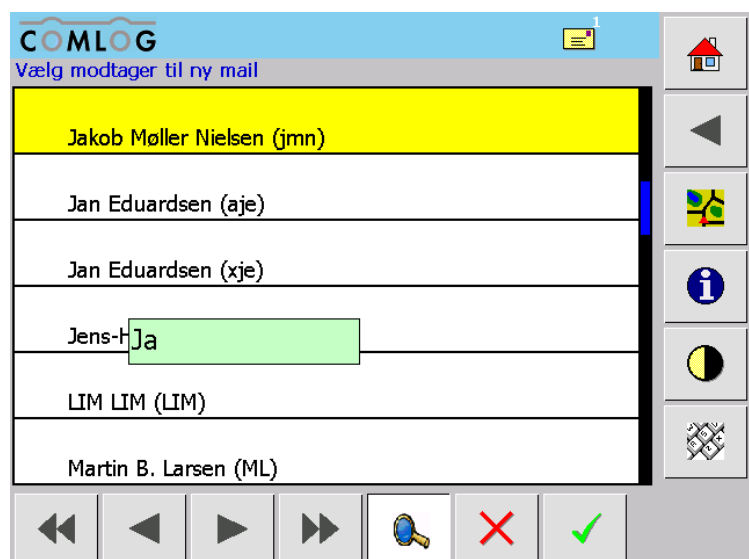
As previously you can select a receiver by touching the display or by using the arrows.

Use the new search function to find the receiver:



In the example to the right the search key is activated. Enter the first letters of the receiver's name (keyboard required).

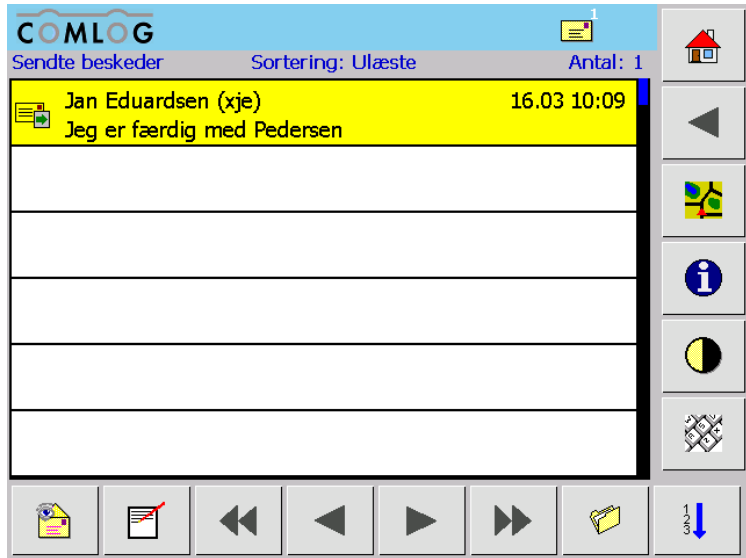
Mark the wanted receiver and confirm with



d) When did the receiver read your mail

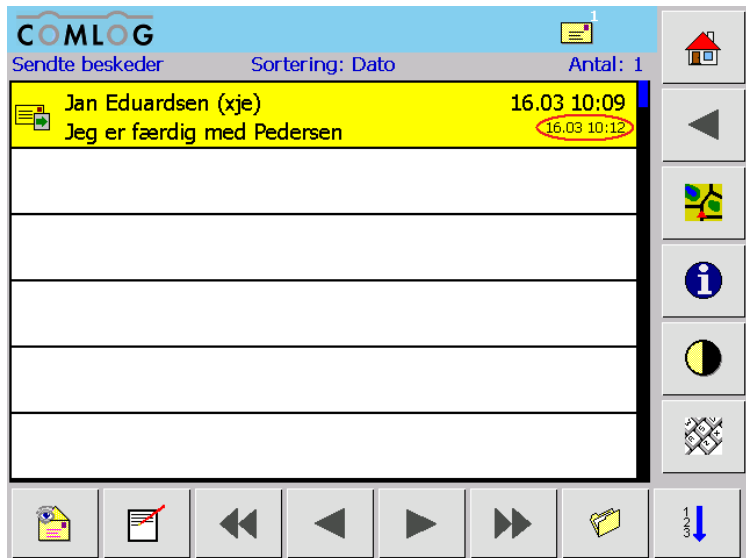
In this example a message was sent to the office from the onboard unit on 16.03 at 10:09

The message has still not been read by the receiver.



The message has now been read by the receiver. The message was read on 16.03 at 10:12 which time now also appears below the time it was sent.

(See red marking in example to the right)

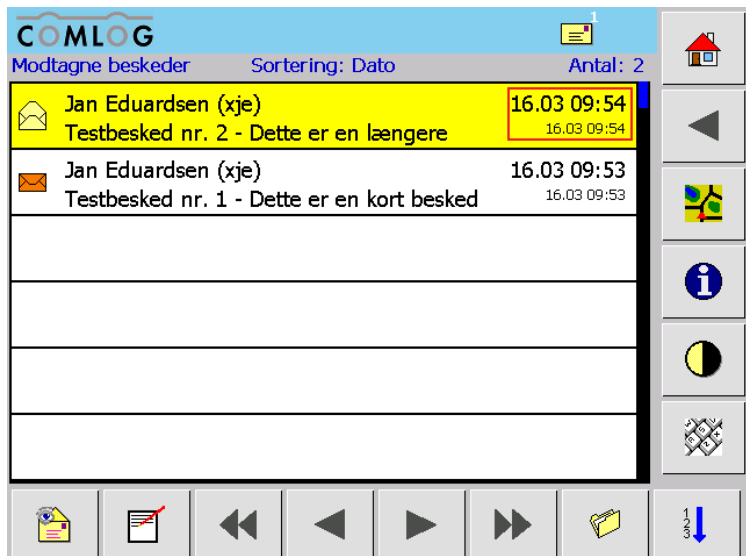


e) When was the message received in the onboard unit

The time when a message was received in the onboard unit appears on the below line in the list on received messages.

The top line shows when the message was sent from COMLOG Fleet.

Missing GPRS coverage may cause a time gap between the two times.



f) Sort by unread messages

NOTE: If you have read a new message via the pop-up window upon receipt, but still not confirmed the receipt of the message, then it will still appear as unread in the list (see example). A new feature now gives you the opportunity to sort by unread messages.

In this example the message list is sorted by the date of receipt.

Press the sorting key:



The keys below on the display changes.



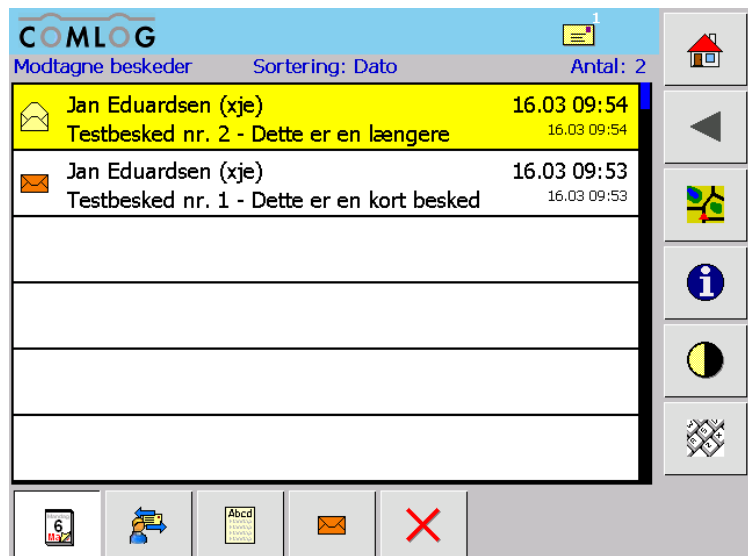
Activate the new function by the



key.

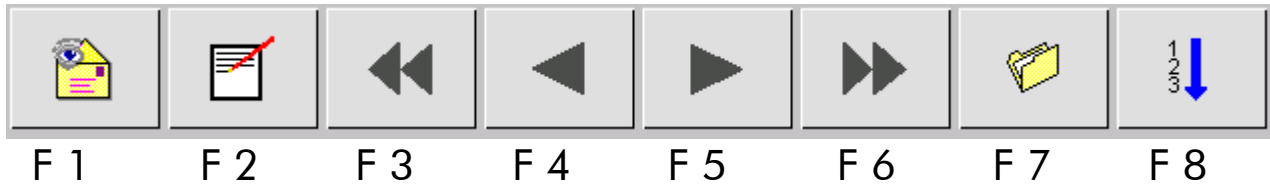
(Sort by unread messages).

The keys below on the display switch back and the unread messages appear from the top of the list.



2. Operating the onboard unit by the keyboard

Now you can operate the onboard unit by the F1 – F8 function keys of the keyboard.



The shown keys are only an example from the Message module. You can use the F keys on any key panel in the on-board unit.

The same applies for the keys to the right on the display. Here you first press and release the CTRL key and then press and release the F key.

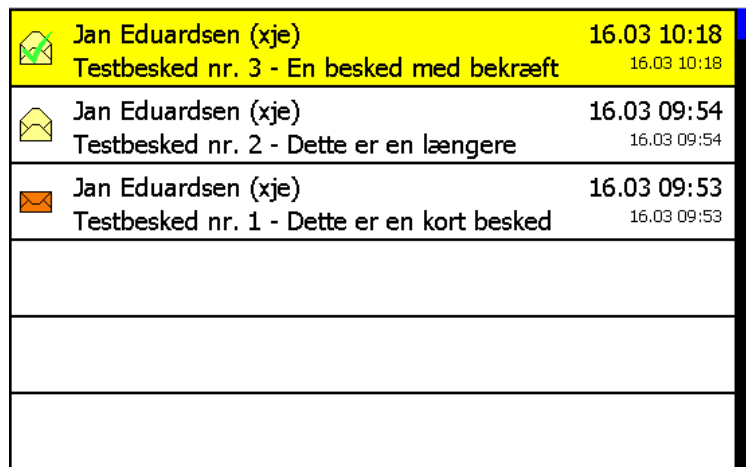


CTRL followed by F 1. (Example: Press **CTRL** followed by **F 3** to activate the Navigation system)

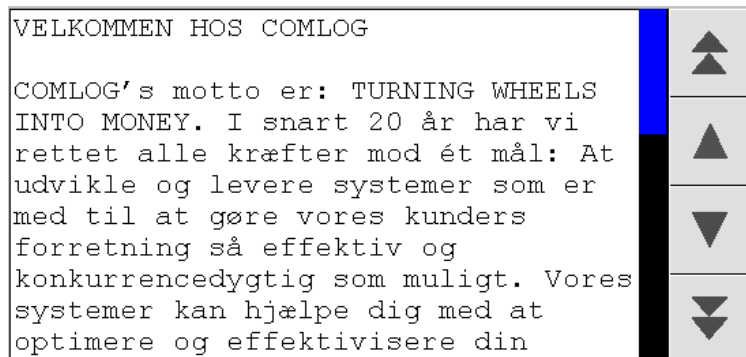
You can navigate in lists by using the arrow keys of the keyboard.

Use the keys 'Home' and 'End' to go to the first or the last element respectively.

When you have marked the wanted element, press the Enter key to select it.





In text fields you can go to the next and the previous line by the arrow keys. To go to the next or the previous page, use the 'Page-up' and the 'Page down' keys respectively.



3. Russian and Polish language

Russian* and Polish now available in the onboard unit.

1: Press  in the main menu.

2: Press  to select the language menu

3: Select a language and confirm.

**Russian is shown in Latin letters, not in Cyrillic letters.*
